1. Clarify Your Project Goals

- Revisit your Erasmus+ application and highlight your core goals.
- Identify the staff and departments that will benefit most from training.
- Align your upcoming mobilities with your school development plan.

2. Choose the Right Training Provider

- Look for providers with practicing educators and experience in Erasmus+.
- Ensure training aligns with leadership, inclusion, innovation, or other project themes.
- Ask about pre/post-learning support and certification.

3. Prepare Your Logistics


- Confirm travel dates that avoid busy school periods.
- Book accommodation and transport well in advance.
- Organise internal cover and communicate clearly with staff.

4. Make the Learning Stick

- Assign reflection tasks or practical goals pre-course.
- Build in time for sharing and collaboration.
- Plan how staff will implement and share learning when back.

5. Plan for Long-Term Impact

- Set up follow-up workshops or mentoring sessions.
- Capture impact stories and examples for future projects.
- Begin scoping your next Erasmus+ initiative early.
